ORDINANCE NO. 372

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT CERTAIN VEHICLES FROM PARKING WITHIN CITY LIMITS AND EXCEPTIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLUE HILL, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Chapter 5, Article 6, Section 614, of the Municipal Code of Blue Hill, Nebraska be amended to read as follows:

PARKING: CERTAIN VEHICLES PROHIBITED; EXCEPTIONS. It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of a semi-trailer-truck with trailer attached or unattached, except emergency vehicles, to park on the streets within the City, except when being used for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods, wares, merchandise or materials and then only for a period of time no longer than is necessary for the expeditious delivery or collecting of goods, wares, merchandise or materials; Provided, that the provisions of this section shall not apply to trucks or motor vehicles being used within the City in connection with building, repair, service or moving operations, or trucks or motor vehicles parked off of the travel lane of the street in industrially zoned areas, or trucks or motor vehicles parked in areas which the Governing Body, by resolution, has designated to be a proper area for the parking of said vehicles, said area to be indicated by an adequate number of signs. (Ref. 39-697 R.S. Neb.)

Section 2. That any ordinance or section passed and approved prior to the passage, approval, and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as required by law.
